  - Operational objective: To identify the various emerging hospital pharmaceutical technologies, such as the validation of aseptic preparations, the circulation and secure management of high-risk healthcare products, stability studies, and the design and monitoring of centralised cytotoxic preparation units within pharmacies.
  
2. Exploring new paradigms in hospital pharmacy practice:
  - Operational objective: Assess the evolving role of the hospital pharmacist in the production of innovative therapies, such as biotherapies, by identifying and assessing the risks associated with their production.

  - **Short oral presentations** and **posters** presenting original work carried out in hospital pharmacies and selected by the Scientific Advisory Board.
  - **Five interactive workshops in parallel sessions** to address professional practice issues such as, this year, **validating the implementation of an aseptic process** or **implementing stability studies in the hospital environment**.
